## Adventure Dives

**Wreck Diving** - Become an expert on the wreck of the ex-HMAS Brisbane. One of Scuba World's instructors will teach you how to select the best wreck sites, selecting the best equipment for your skill level, diving at a wreck site, and handling situations that can arise.
